- 2. Select " Printers & Scanners"




3. The Printers & Scanners window may be locked, to unlock, click the lock and enter your credentials.




4. Click "Add a Printer" by selecting the plus sign at the bottom of the window.




5. After the new window opens, control + click on the top of the new window and select "Customize Toolbar"
