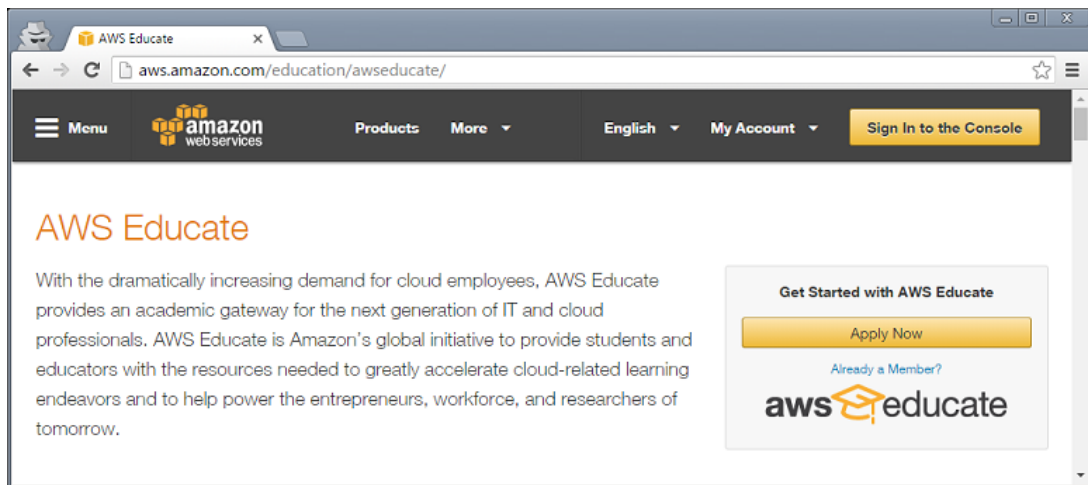

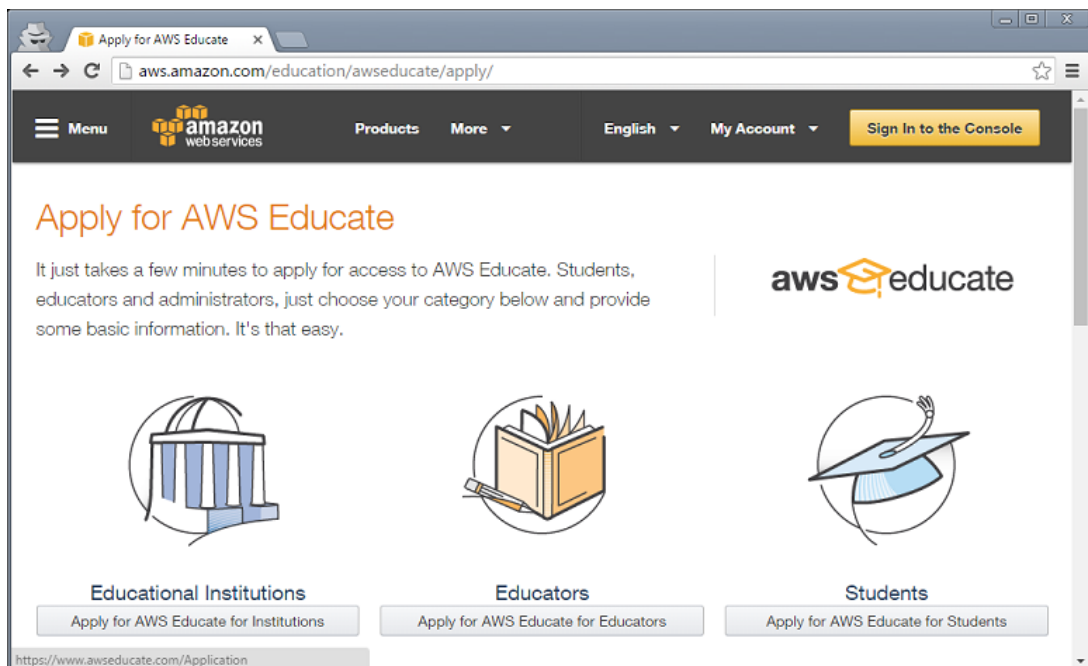

To apply for the Amazon AWS Educate program, you'll need an AWS account. If you haven't already created one, follow these [instructions](#) and then return to this document.

Step 1: Go to aws.amazon.com/education/awseducate/ and click *Apply Now*.



Step 2: Click *Apply for AWS Educate for Students*.



Step 3: Complete the application. Make sure to enter **Southern Oregon University** in the Institution Name field and **use your SOU email account in the Email field**. You will

also need your Amazon AWS Account ID (not your email address, see this [article](#) for help). Click *Next* when finished.
