


In order to remove your old name/email address from Google after a name change, you may need to remove your old email from the '**Frequent**' or the '**Frequently Contacted**' list in your **Contacts**, as well as the lists of others who may have contacted you prior to the name change.

How to Open and Access Gmail Contacts


- Open Gmail.
- Select the Apps icon in the upper right. (The nine dots in a square or the waffle menu icon)



- $\bullet \;$ Select Contacts, which will open a new window with all your email addresses in it.
- $\bullet \ \ Select \ "Frequent" \ or \ "Frequently \ contacted" \ and \ then \ search \ [previous \ name \ and/or \ email \ address].$



• Click the three vertical dots and click 'Delete'.
