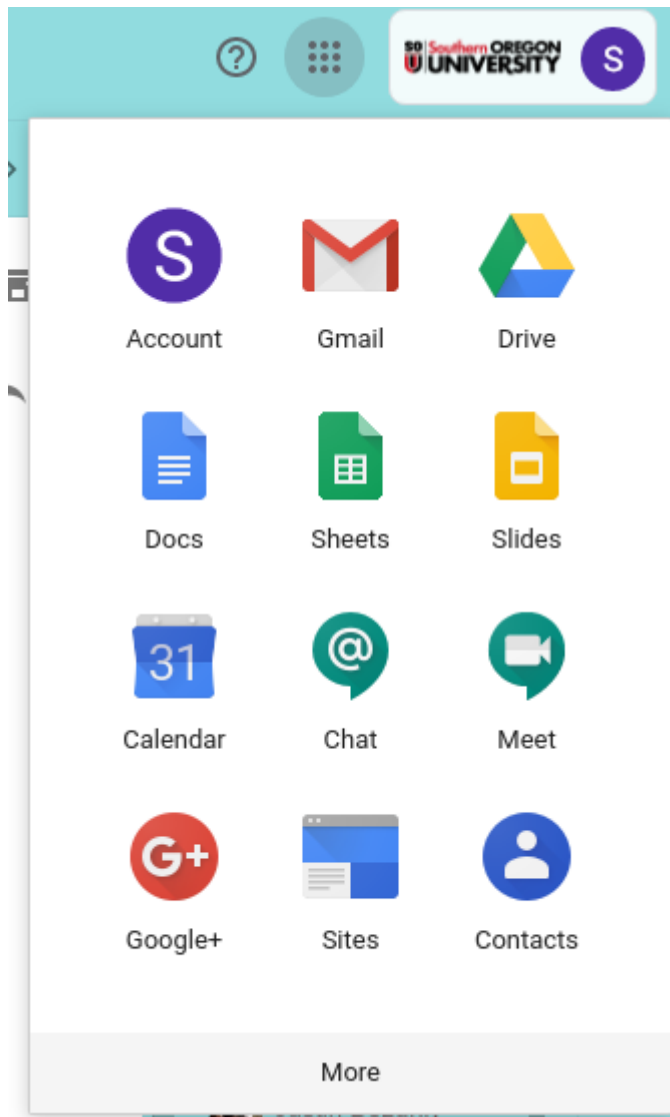
## Clear Frequently Contacted with Old Name/Email Address

In order to remove your old name/email address from Google after a name change, you may need to remove your old email from the '**Frequent**' or the '**Frequently Contacted**' list in your **Contacts**, as well as the lists of others who may have contacted you prior to the name change.

### How to Open and Access Gmail Contacts

- Open **Gmail**.
- Select the **Apps icon** in the upper right. (The nine dots in a square or the **waffle menu icon**)



- Select **Contacts**, which will open a new window with all your email addresses in it.
- Select "**Frequent**" or "**Frequently contacted**" and then search [previous name and/or email address].

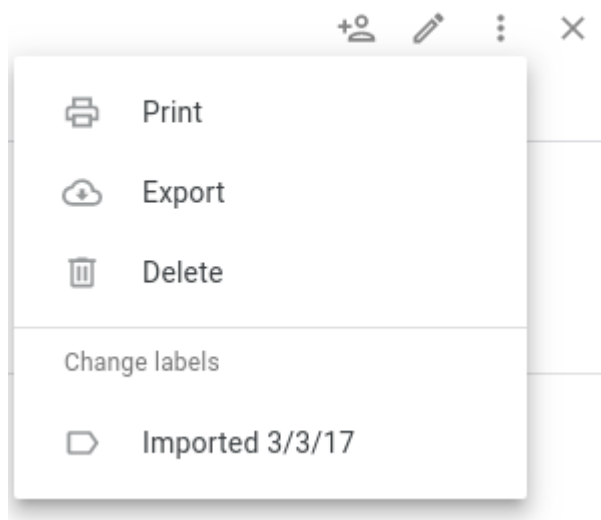
