



Connect Macbook to projector

1. Make sure your laptop is turned off.
2. Ensure all AV cables (HDMI or VGA, Audio and Network) are connected to your laptop.
3. Press the **LAPTOP** button on the AV control panel. The data project may take a minute to warm up.
4. Turn on your laptop.

Mirror Mode:

If you want your laptop image to display on a data projector screen, follow the steps below:

1. Go to **System Preferences > Displays**, and select the resolution **1024 x 768** (not stretched) on the left side of the window.



2. Next, select the **Arrangement** tab.
3. Make sure the box next to **Mirror Displays** is checked.
