The easiest place to find courses is in the **My courses list** in the blocks panel on the right side of your course (you may need to expand the panel in order to see it). Courses you are teaching will be listed there regardless of visibility status. Note that if you star a course in your dashboard, the star will be displayed in your course list in the block.

Courses are also found on our **Home** page as well as via links to our **Dashboard** and **My courses** in the top border of Moodle. On the Home page, new course shells will be located below the last course in your list that is available to students. In your Dashboard and My courses links, the **Course overview** section has a **Search** field where you can enter a course name or CRN and bring up a link to the course. Note that even courses that you have removed from view will appear in the search results.
