Courses are found on our **Home** page as well as via links to our **Dashboard** and **My courses** in the top border of Moodle. On the Home page, new course shells will be located below the last course in your list that is available to students. In your Dashboard and My courses links, the **Course overview** section has a **Search** field where you can enter a course name or CRN and bring up a link to the course. Note that even courses that you have removed from view will appear in the search results.
