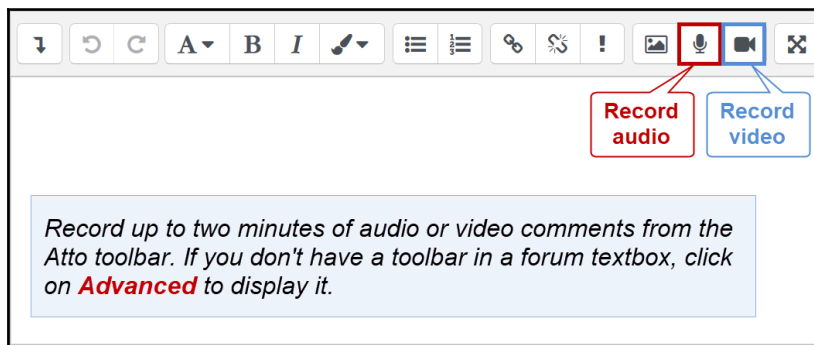

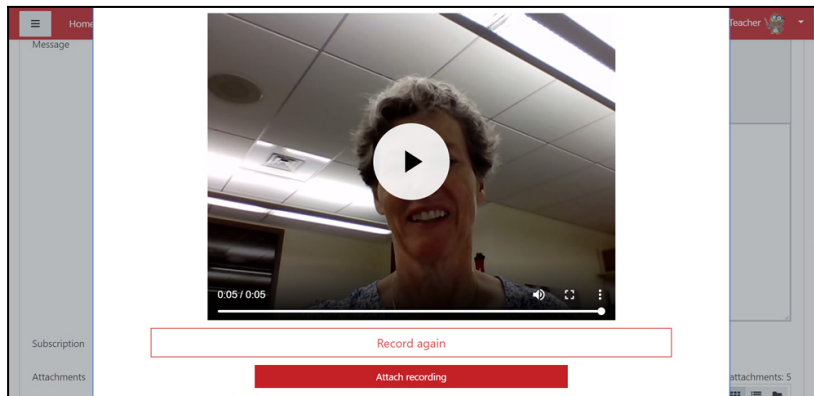
To create an audio or video recording of up to two minutes, open a textbox using the [Atto editor](#) and click on the appropriate icon. Click on the **Start recording** button. When you're done speaking, click on **Stop recording**, then click on **Attach recording** or **Record again**, depending on how happy you are with the result.

Note: In a forum post, if you don't see the toolbar, click on **Advanced** to display it.
