## Faculty: Repair Group Choice Link

We love the <u>group choice</u> activity which enrolls learners in a group based on their choosing it! It's just so efficient.

BUT...

....there's a bug in the system. When you import a group choice activity from a prior term's course, the choices made by the students in that prior term will appear to exist in your new course -- even though those students aren't enrolled and haven't made a choice.

When you open the link, it might look like this:
