

How to Connect to SOU-Wireless (Mac)

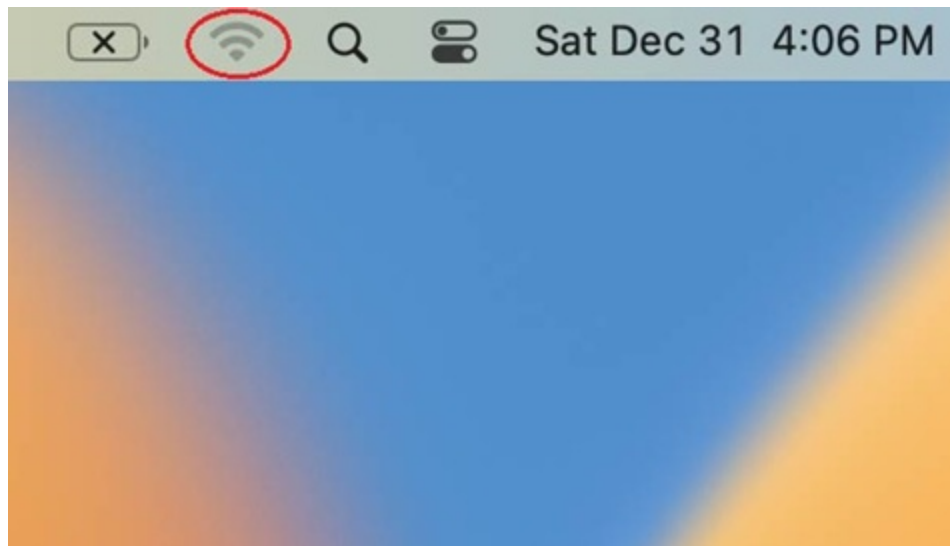

This article will walk you through how to connect to our open wireless network, **SOU-Wireless**, from any Wi-Fi-enabled Apple computer running **Mac OS**.

How to connect to a Mac OS:

1. Locate the **AirPort/Wi-Fi** status icon in the top-right corner of your screen.

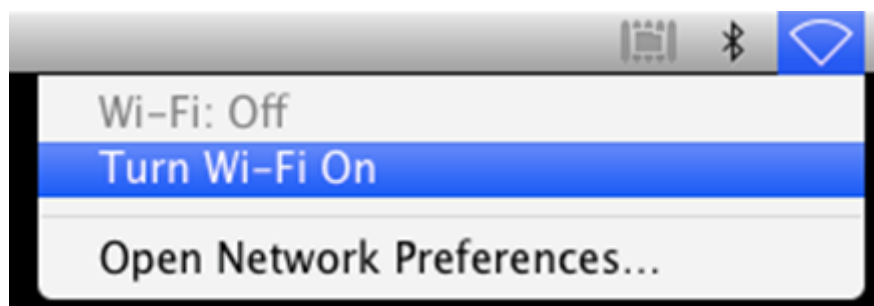
1. If this icon is missing, follow the instructions [here](#) to enable it.

Note

If your status icon appears blank as depicted below, you will need to enable your **wireless adapter** before proceeding. Just click the icon, then select **Turn Wi-Fi On** or **Turn AirPort On** depending on which version of Mac OS you're running.

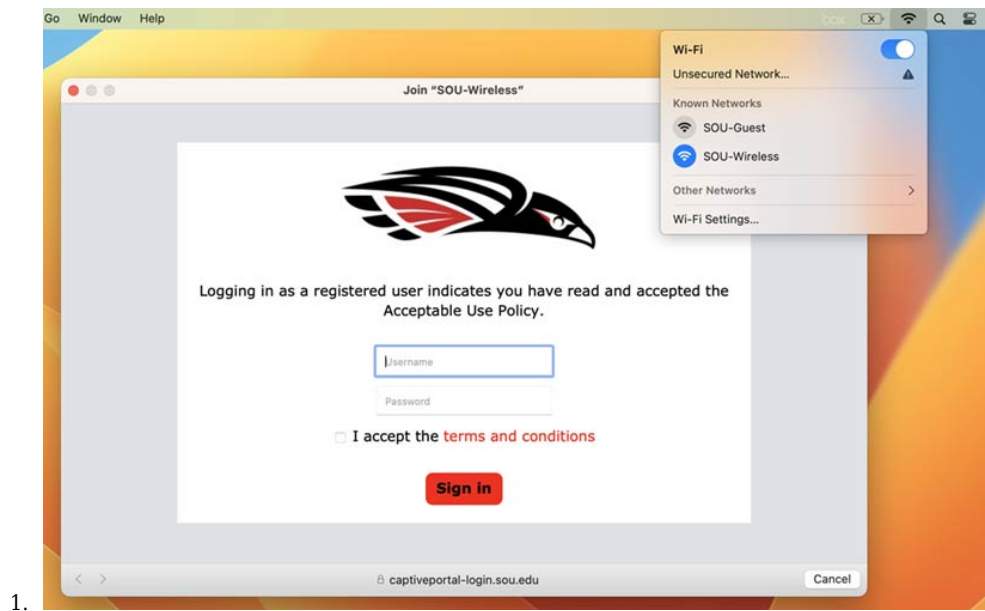


2. Once your wireless adapter is enabled, it should quickly present you with a list of all the available wireless networks within range of your computer. Find **SOU-Wireless** in the list and click on it.



If you select SOU-Wireless you will need to follow the steps below to sign in:

1. A **Portal Login** window will open when you select **SOU-Wireless**, and ask for a username and password. Enter your **SOU school username** and password.



2. Upon successful authentication you will see the following message.
