

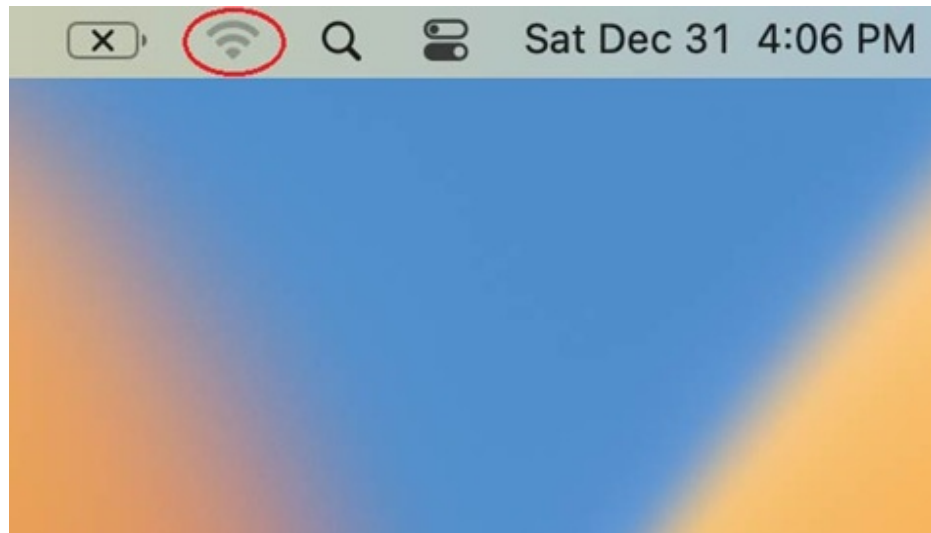
## How to Connect to SOU-Wireless (Mac)

This article will walk you through how to connect to our open wireless network, SOU-Wireless, from any Wi-Fi-enabled Apple computer running Mac OS X.

How to connect to a Mac OS:

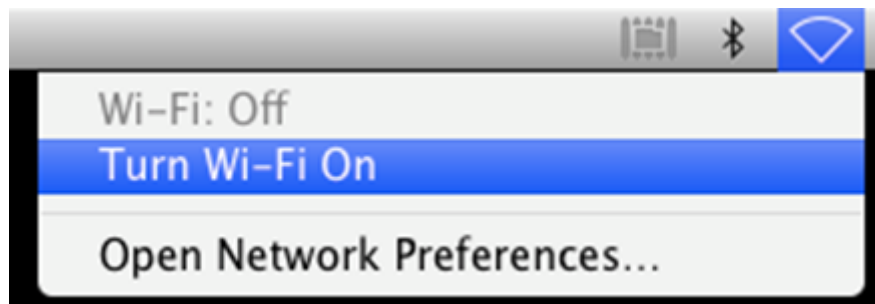
1. Locate the AirPort/Wi-Fi status icon in the top-right corner of your screen.
  1. If this icon is missing, follow the instructions [here](#) to enable it.

### Note

If your status icon appears blank as depicted below, you will need to enable your wireless adapter before proceeding. Just click the icon, then select "Turn Wi-Fi On" or "Turn AirPort On" depending on which version of Mac OS X you're running.



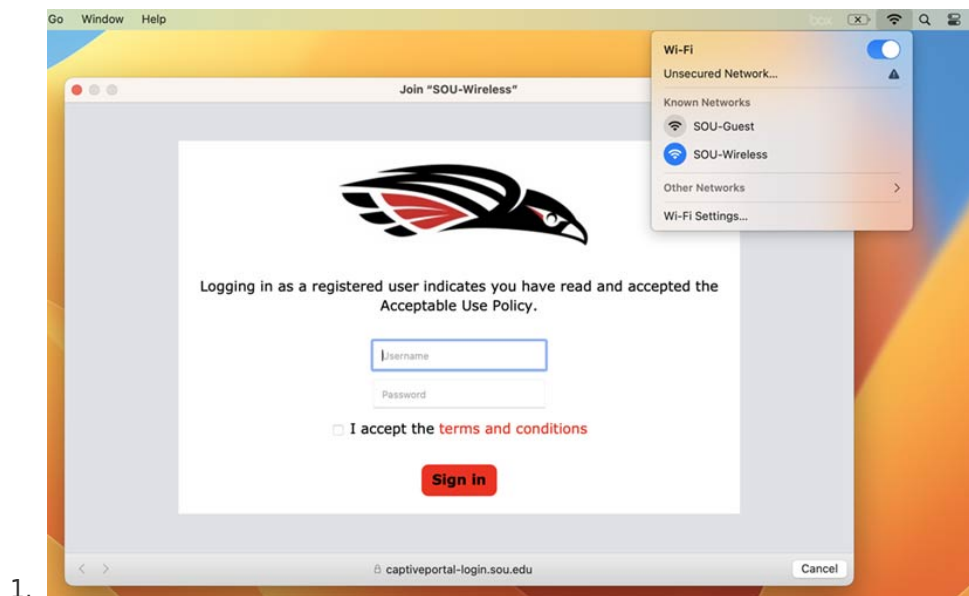
2. Once your wireless adapter is enabled, it should quickly present you with a list of all the available wireless networks within range of your computer. Find **SOU-Wireless**

in the list and click on it.



**If you select SOU-Wireless you will need to follow the steps below to sign in:**

1. A Portal Login window will open when you select SOU-Wireless, and ask for a username and password. Enter your SOU school username and password (do not put the @sou.edu from your email address):



2. Upon successful authentication you will see the following screens:
