This article will walk you through how to connect to our open wireless network, SOU-Wireless, from any Wi-Fi-enabled Apple computer running Mac OS X.

How to connect to a Mac OS:

- 1. Locate the AirPort/Wi-Fi status icon in the top-right corner of your screen.
 - 1. If this icon is missing, follow the instructions <u>here</u> to enable it.



Note

If your status icon appears blank as depicted below, you will need to enable your wireless adapter before proceeding. Just click the icon, then select "Turn Wi-Fi On" or "Turn AirPort On" depending on which version of Mac OS X you're running.



2. Once your wireless adapter is enabled, it should quickly present you with a list of all the available wireless networks within range of your computer. Find **SOU-Wireless**

in the list and click on it.
