This article will show you how to enable Flash in your web browser. These features are likely to stop working by the end of 2020 when [Adobe officially ends all support for their Flash technology](#). You should avoid using Flash content after December 2020 because web browsers will stop supporting it.

Download and enable the Flash plugin:
