

## How to Update Windows to the Latest Version

This article will show you how to safely update your version of Windows 11 to the latest version from Microsoft.

### Note

- The IT Department restricts Windows updates coming through our system in order to give us time to thoroughly test Microsoft's substantial updates before rolling them out to campus.
- Also, if you did not come to this article because your Computing Coordinator asked you to install the latest Windows 11 version, then please check with [your Computing Coordinator](#) before proceeding.
- If you want to verify that the update completed, you can [note your version of Windows 10](#) before the update and then check it again after the update.

### Warning

- Although this upgrade process is **non-destructive** to your data, it may significantly change **Windows** or break the **functionality** of certain programs.
- We **strongly** recommend that you [back up your local data](#)(<-- click for instructions) and [back up your web browser bookmarks](#)(<-- click for instructions) **before** proceeding! We have *never* seen this upgrade erase data for people, but you can never be too safe.
- The update process can take upwards of one hour. You *can continue to work* while the update installs for part of the process, but please *avoid* working in documents that need to be saved because **you will not receive much of a warning** before the computer reboots.

### How to Update through Software Center

Follow these instructions if and only if you are using a **SOU**-issued Windows computer while


on the **SOU** campus.

### Step 1 - Launch Software Center

Follow the instructions in our [KB article on Software Center](#).


### Step 2 - Find and Install the OS Update

Click on **Operating Systems** in the side bar menu on the left side of the **Software Center** window, then select the **Win11 Upgrade** item in the apps list. It should be the only item there.



### Step 3 - Installation

Click the **Install** button to start the installation, then verify one more time that you wish to start the installation. Once you start, you cannot cancel.



You should see a progress window as the update installs. It can take upwards of 45 minutes for this window to go away, then your computer will reboot several times to finish the upgrade, which can take another 15 minutes or longer.

When the update is finished, sign in to Windows again as you usually would.
