

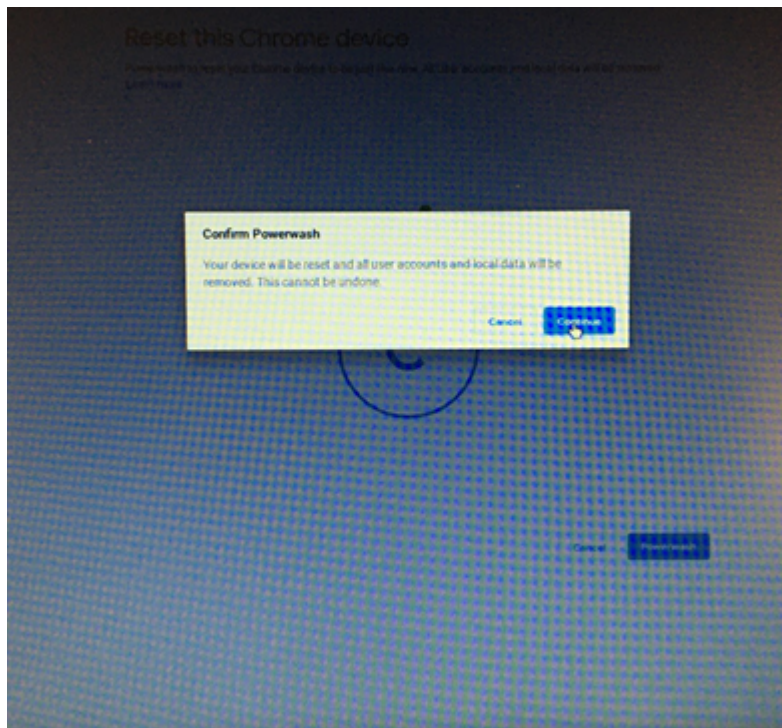
Powerwash and Enterprise Enroll Chromebooks.

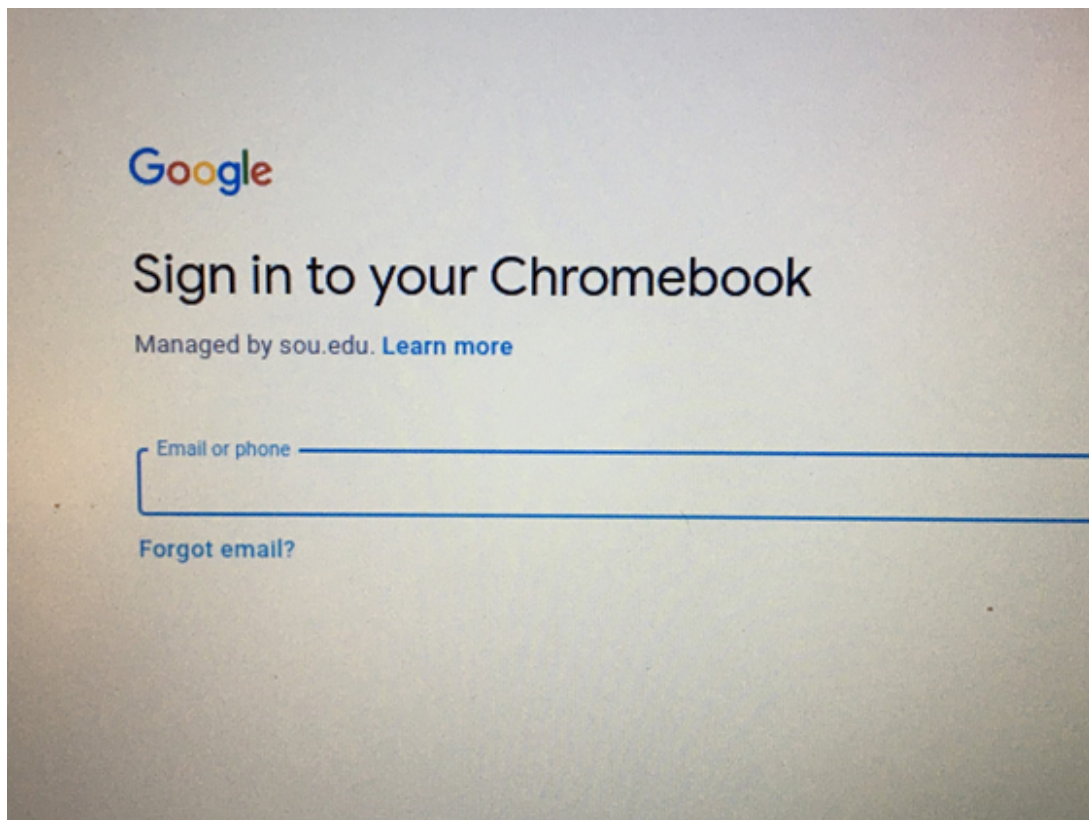
These instructions will go over what you will need to do to **Powerwash (Factory Reset)** for **Chromebooks**.

To enable **Powerwash** make sure that you are currently ***signed out*** of any account that is currently logged into the device.

- Press **CTRL+SHIFT+ALT+R** to bring up the **Powerwash** screen.
- A box will come up to confirm **Powerwash**. Click **Continue**.

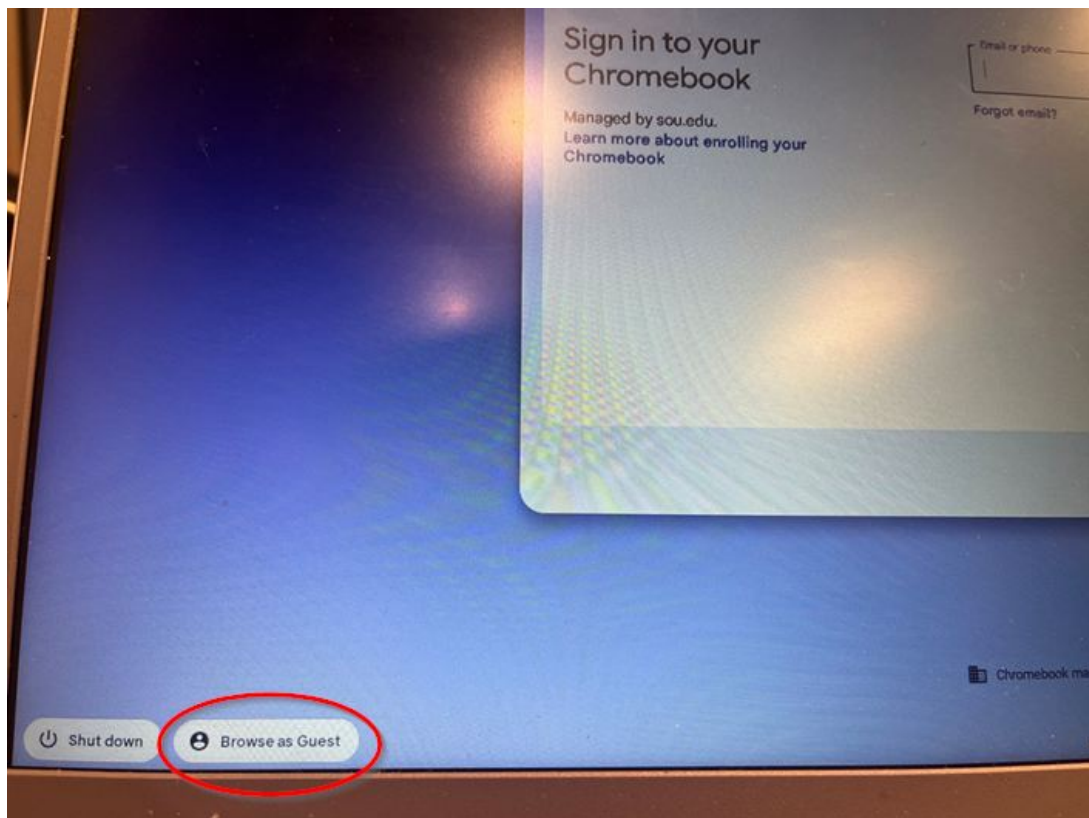


- The device will **restart** to **Powerwash** and go through the ***first time setup*** again.
- After Selecting your **network**, you will be taken to a screen that refers to **Enterprise Enrollment** being completed.
- You will know when the **Chromebook** is properly **enrolled** when you see "**Managed by SOU**" on the ***sign-in*** page.



How to update without signing in.

- If you would like to do more you can **update *WITHOUT* signing in.**
- Click the **Browse as Guest** button.



- Search for **Settings** >> **About ChromeOS** >> **Check for Update**.
