While we appreciate pop-up blockers **most** of the time, they can interfere with how we experience Moodle. The following instructions describe how to allow (or "white list") pop-ups that originate in Moodle if you are using the Chrome browser. For Firefox, the steps are similar -- it's all about privacy and security settings.

- 1. Begin by clicking on the three stacked dots resembling a snowman's buttons in the upper right corner to customize your settings.
- 2. Select **Settings**.
- Select Privacy and security from the menu on the left and scroll down to Cookies and other site data link.
- $4. \ \ \mbox{Open the link and select \textbf{Add} under the $\textbf{Customized behaviors}$ option.}$
- 5. Type moodle.sou.edu in the textbox and click on Add.
