While we appreciate pop-up blockers **most** of the time, they can interfere with how we experience Moodle. The following instructions describe how to allow (or "white list") pop-ups that originate in Moodle if you are using the Chrome browser. For Firefox, the steps are similar -- it's all about privacy and security settings.

- 1. Begin by clicking on the three stacked dots resembling a snowman's buttons in the upper right corner to customize your settings.
- 2. Select Settings.
- 3. Select **Privacy and security** from the menu on the left and scroll down to **Cookies and other site data** link.
- 4. Open the link and select Add under the Customized behaviors option.
- 5. Type **moodle.sou.edu** in the textbox and click on **Add**.
