Courses appear for you in Moodle after instructors make them available to you. Courses are found on our **Home** page as well as via links to our **Dashboard** and **My courses** in the top border of Moodle. In your Dashboard and My courses links, the **Course overview** section has a **Search** field where you can enter a course name or CRN and bring up a link to the course. Note that even courses that you have removed from view will appear in the search results.
