With the release of Moodle 3.8, forums have a new look and function a little differently. See this [complete guide to participating in forums](#) ([accessible version in Word](#)) if you are new to Moodle. The illustration below shows how you can:

- Star a post to move it to the top of your display (note that this applies only to your view, not everyone else's).
- Click on the button on the right of a post to *subscribe* to that thread. You'll get an email any time someone replies to it.
- New replies are highlighted in the **Replies** column.
