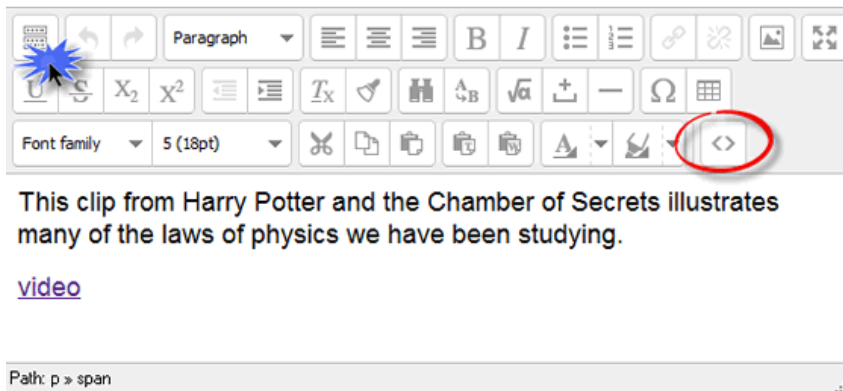


Students: Troubleshoot a Video Link

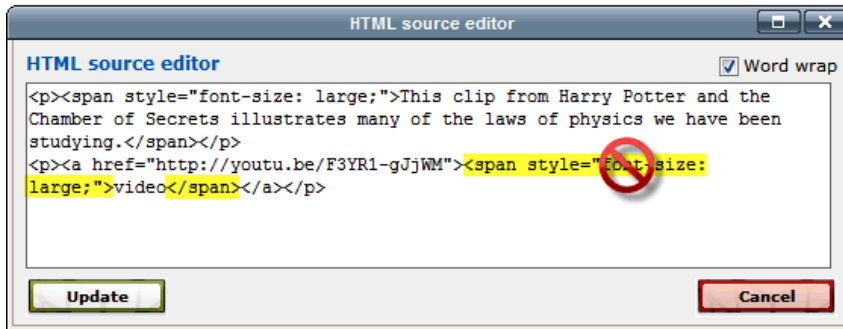

So, you've added a link to a video to a forum post or other text box, but the video player doesn't display. There's a simple fix for one problem that might be preventing the video player from being displayed: hidden formatting codes.

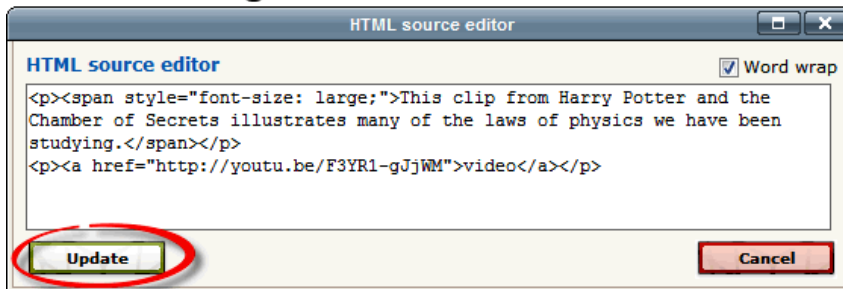
1. Click on **Toggle** icon, then click on **Edit HTML source**.



2. Select and delete **extra code**.



3. Click on **Update** to save revised code, then **Save changes**.



This clip from Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets illustrates many of the laws of physics we have been studying. To check for hidden

formatting:

1. Reveal Source Code

Click on the **Toggle** icon in the upper left corner to display all three rows of the editing toolbar, then click on the **Edit HTML source** icon in the lower right corner.

2. Check for Extra Code

The source code for the video link will start off with `<a href=http://` and continue with the video's URL. In the example shown in #2 at right, the code for the video's location is followed by additional code (``), then the word **video** appears (the word that the URL was linked to in the text box), followed by the code to close this formatting (``). Select and delete the additional text.

3. Save Revised Code

Click on **Update** to save your revisions and return to the text box. **Save changes**. Does the video player appear now?
